

Student Assessment during Covid-19 – How will my work be assessed? - for all instances where the first submission deadline is after 20 March 2020

Students should aim to complete and submit their assessment work as normal, inline with published deadlines and assessment briefs. As part of the University’s response to the coronavirus, we are moving to a position where students will have 3 opportunities to submit assignments. This does NOT mean that you can resit work twice in order to pass, it just means that you have 3 ‘final deadlines’ that you can work towards, allowing you the opportunity to better manage your time and other commitments in the light of the coronavirus lockdown. Possible scenarios are shown below.
